- 1 2-inch 3-ring binder (any color)
- 2 bottles of Elmer's glue (4 oz size)
- 6 sticks of Elmer's glue
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (16- or 24-count)
- 1 box of "fat" Crayola crayons (8-count)
- 1 package of "fat" Crayola markers
- 1 set of Crayola watercolor paints
- 1 box of #2 pencils
- 1 12-inch ruler, preferably translucent
- 1 pad of lined "learn to write" paper
- 1 package of 12x18-inch manila paper
- 1 package of 9x12-inch construction paper
- 1 package of cardstock (8.5x11-inch, any color)
- 1 smock (a large old t-shirt or dress shirt works well)
- 1 package of Expo dry-erase markers
