These are needed right away. They stay at home and are used for homework in grades K-3., If you ordered them last year and still have them, you are all set.

- 2 Mead composition books-wide ruled but NOT primary
- 20-30 Ticonderoga brand pencils
- 1 red ballpoint pen
- 1 blue ball point pen
- 1 fat highlighter (any color)
- 1 Pink Pearl eraser
- 1 pair of scissors (children's Fiskars are best)
- 3 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 box of 24 or more Crayola crayons
- 1 box of 24 or more Crayola colored pencils
- 1 box of Crayola skinny markers
- 1 box of Crayola regular markers-any color collection
- 1 supply box (approximately 8x4 inches in size)
- 1 ruler, centimeters **and** inches (the more basic the ruler, the better)
- 1 green plastic folder **with brads and pockets**
